#### Book Week

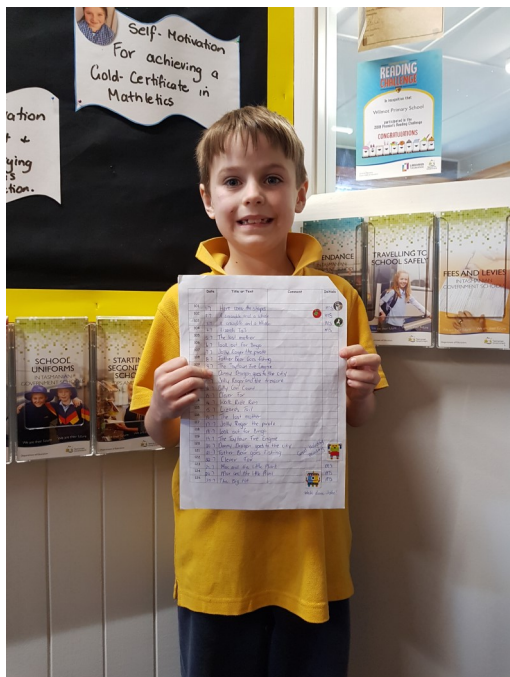

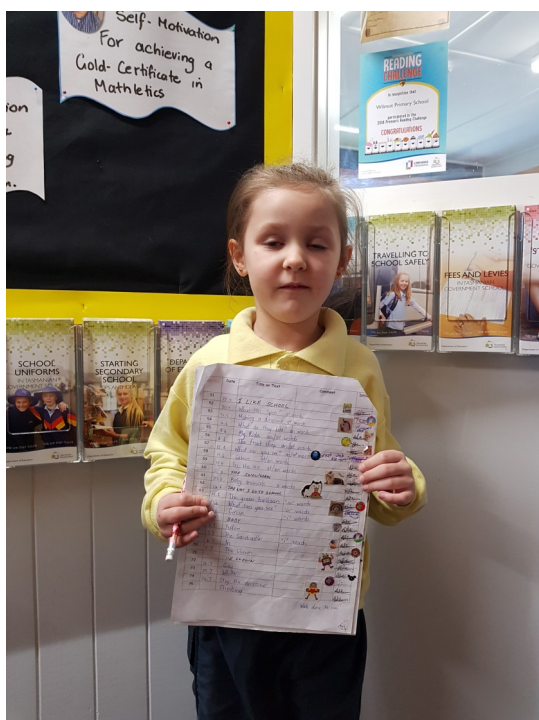

This year we practiced Boundary and Field Umpire skills, along with kicking and handball.



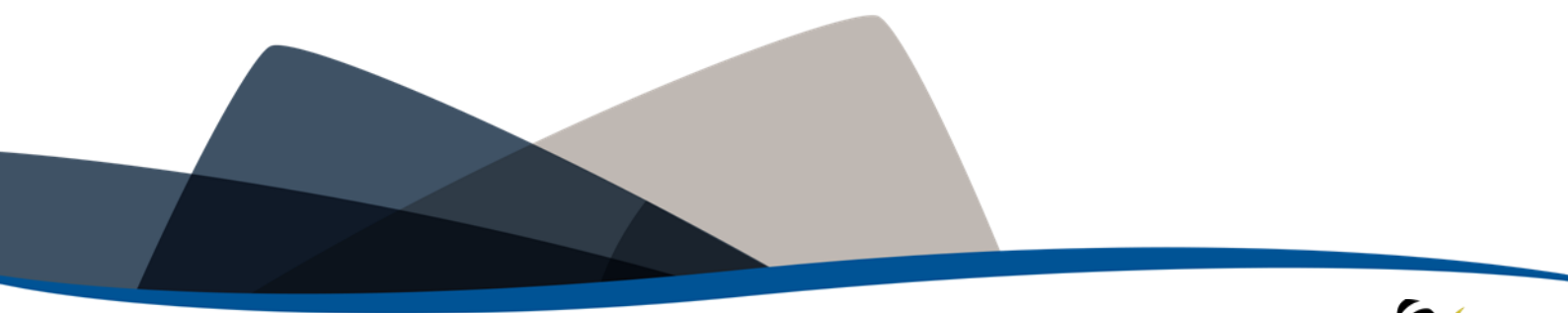


## **Cricket Clinic**
