The Farm Committee meeting will commence at 5:00pm and School Association at 5:45pm.

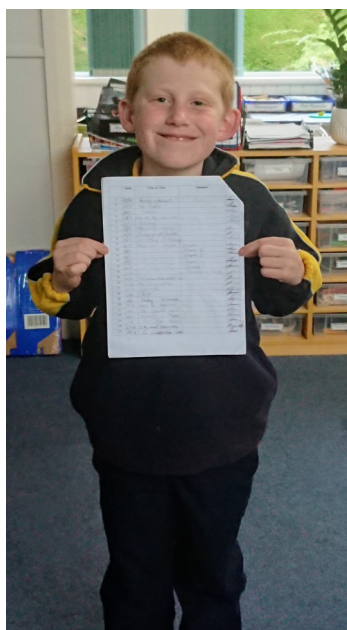
Market

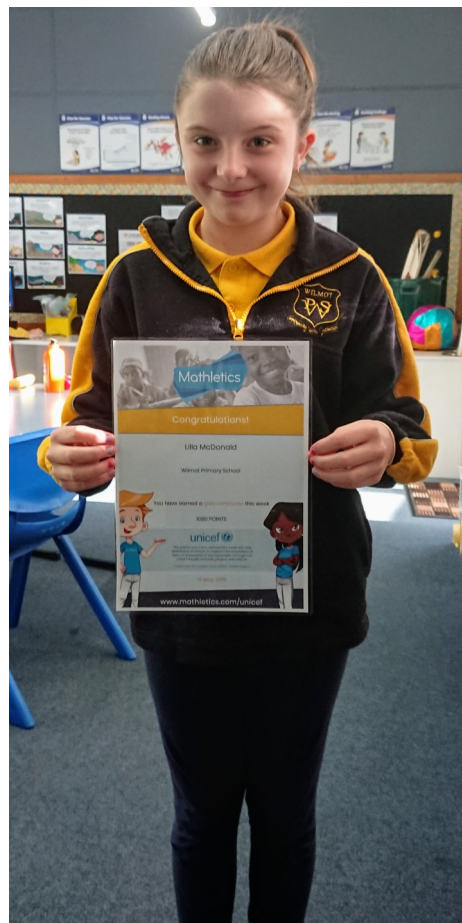
Brixhibition

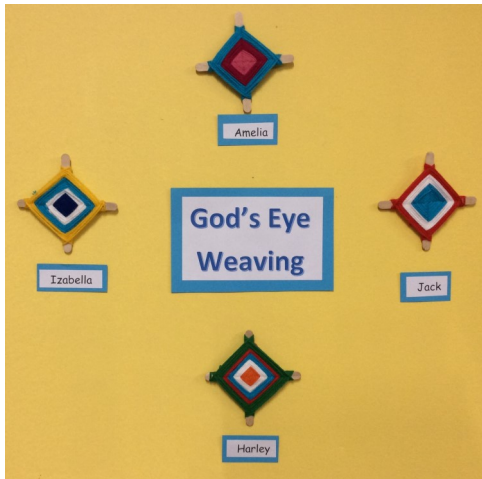

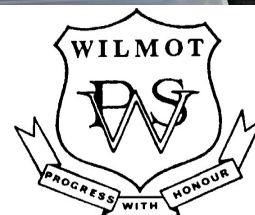
Autumn Writing
