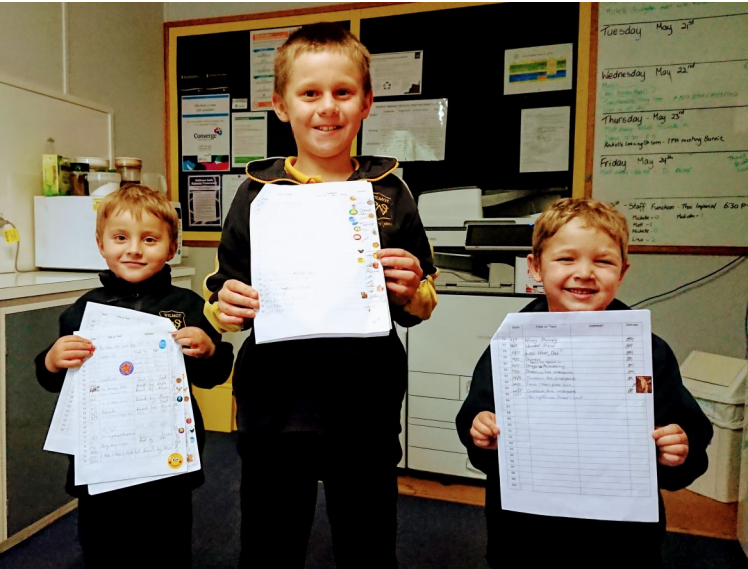
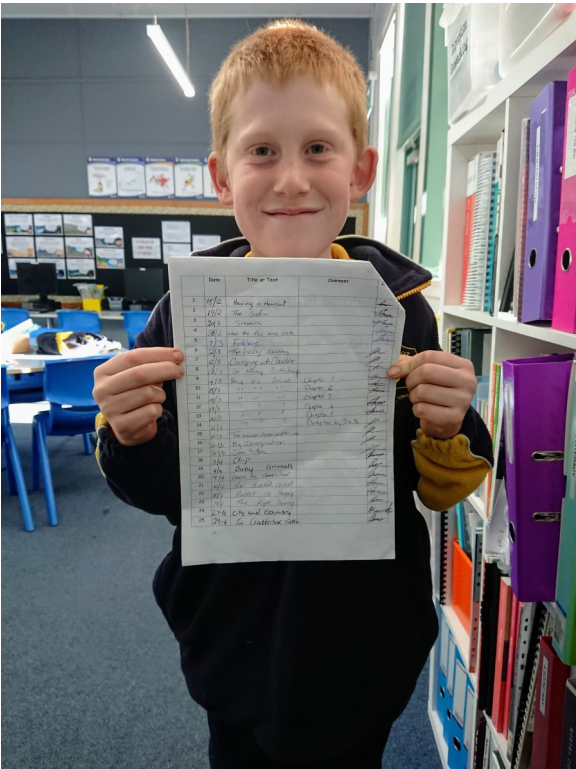
Congratulations to those students who have already completed the reading challenge! Don't forget to return your booklets to get your stickers. There are also prizes to be won for completing book reviews on their website.

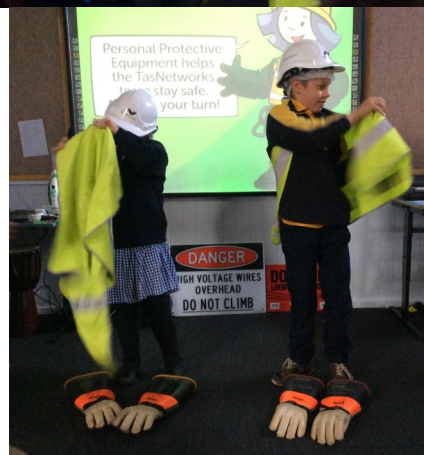
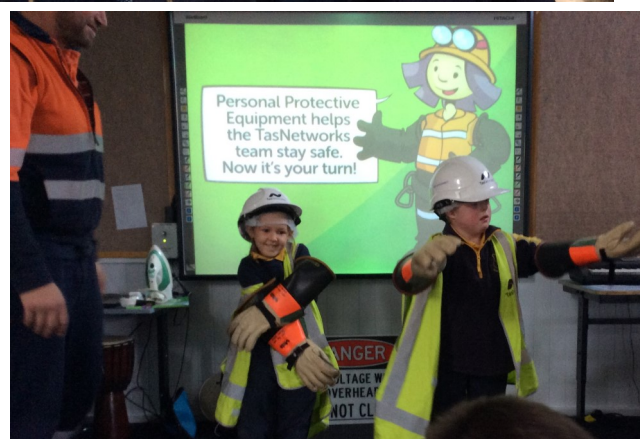
Simultaneous Story Time

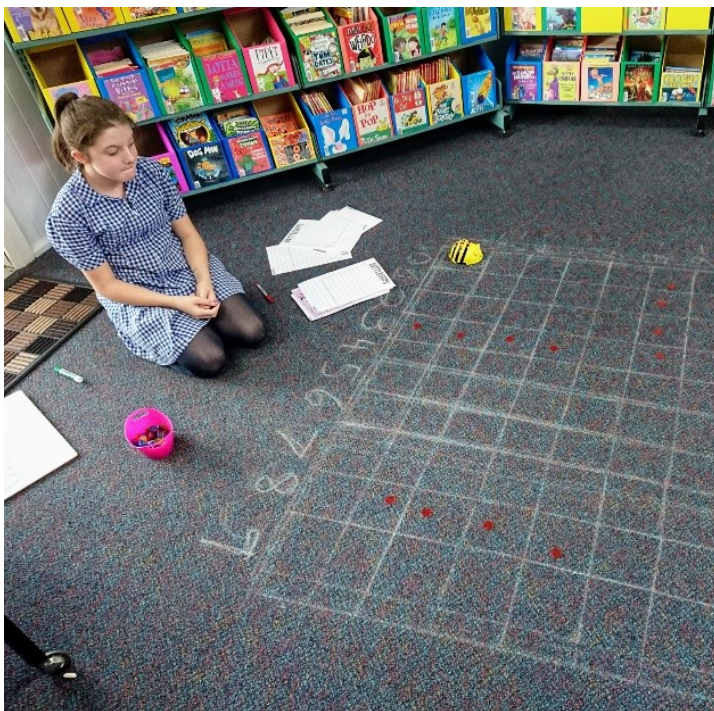
